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Puzzling observation

- The largest local parties are found in northern municipalities like Dorotea, Jokkmokk, Kiruna and Åsele.
- But local parties have also been remarkably successful in municipalities like Sjöbo, Mullsjö and Lidingö.
- What unites these seemingly different cases?
- I found no satisfactory answer in the literature.




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- Local parties appear to prosper where one bloc is dominant in the national elections.
- Unless people split their votes, these municipalities will be characterized by a lack of electoral competition.





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Why local parties?

- Maybe national parties cannot converge around the median voter in local elections.
 - National parties cannot adjust their policies.
 - Voters find it difficult to support different blocs.
- These problems do not affect local parties.



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Hypotheses

- H₂: Local parties are larger in municipalities where one bloc is dominant on the national level.
- H₃: When local parties grow large, they increase electoral competition through their willingness to co-operate with both the left-wing and the right-wing bloc.
- Main method is regression analysis, but I will use illustrative graphs here.



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Results Average vote share for local parties 5.9 4.7 3.6 >60 percent left-wing Neither >60 percent right-wing


Results conditioned on the size of Centerpartiet

Probability of being in incumbent coalition


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>60 percent left-wing in national elections

Probability of being in incumbent coalition


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>60 percent right-wing in national elections





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Possible extensions

- Analyse individual data to see if ideological position is in line with theory (centrist voters from dominant bloc).
- Use the "Kommun- och landstingsfullmäktigeundersökningen" to analyse local party positions.
- RD design to analyse the policy effects.
